Prepositional Phrases...

- always begin with a preposition.
- always end with a noun or pronoun (object).
- might have words in between the preposition and object of the preposition called modifiers.
- can be between 2 to 5 words long, depending on how many modifiers there are (has to be at least 2 words – preposition and object of preposition).
- will never include the subject or verb of the sentence.
